Healthy Kids Program Notice of Cancellation



June 30, 2008

Dear Healthy Kids Member, Parent, or Guardian,

It is with great regret that Alameda Alliance for Health has to inform you that the Healthy Kids Program will be closing. The Healthy Kids Program will end at 11:59 p.m. on September 30, 2008.

Why is the program closing?

The county and the foundations that give the Alliance money to run the program can no longer afford to give us funding to continue Healthy Kids. The Alliance can no longer afford to continue the program past September 30, 2008.

What does this mean for my child (children)?

After September 30, 2008 your child (or children) will no longer be covered by Healthy Kids. You must continue to pay your monthly premium if you want to keep your child's (children's) coverage until September 30th. Your last premium payment will be due August 26, 2008 and that will cover your child (or children) through the September 30, 2008, until the program ends.

What other choices do I have?

Your child (children) might be eligible for a similar plan through the Kaiser Child Health Plan. You can get more information by calling the Kaiser at 800/464.4000. There is also a list of other community resources included at the end of this notice.

What about other Alliance programs?

This does not affect the coverage of anyone else in your household who is enrolled with the Alliance for Medi-Cal, Healthy Families, Alliance CompleteCare and Alliance Group Care.
