



Important Notice: Hospital Notification's Through Admission Discharge Transfer (ADT) Feed, Starting Thursday, February 1, 2024

Alameda Alliance for Health (Alliance) values our dedicated provider partner community. We have an important notice we would like to share with you.

The Alliance currently receives admission notifications (face sheets) via fax when a member is admitted to a hospital. We also receive Admission Discharge Transfer (ADT) feeds, a hospital data feed that provides similar information.

The Alliance can now use the ADT data feed as a form of admission notification and authorization creation for review by our Inpatient Utilization Management Department.

Effective Thursday, February 1, 2024, hospitals currently set up to send ADT feeds to the Alliance may discontinue sending admission face sheets via fax to the Alliance Inpatient Utilization Management Department.

The **ONLY** exceptions where an admission face sheet by fax is still required are:

- Newborn baby notifications
- Newborn babies admitted to the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU)

For the two (2) above exceptions, please continue to send admission face sheets to the Alliance Inpatient Utilization Management Department via fax to **1.855.313.6306**.
